

# Case Study: Step Up For Students schools partner with NWEA and see accelerated student growth

Since the fall of 2017, the SUFS and NWEA partnership has demonstrated results for participants.

- MAP Growth assessments have been given in 215 private schools in Florida serving SUFS scholarship students
- Approximately 25,000 students have been tested
- The percentage of students meeting or exceeding their growth targets grew from 63% to 76%
- 80 to 85% of students in grades 6–12 met math growth goals between fall and spring
