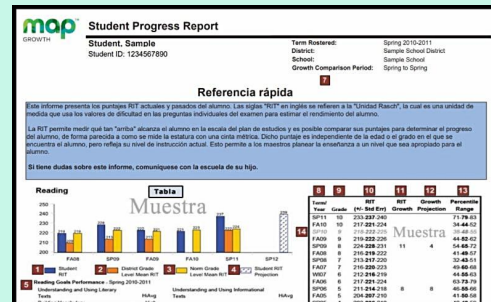
MAP GROWTH CORNER: Resources & Activities for Teachers Using NWEA's MAP Assessment
